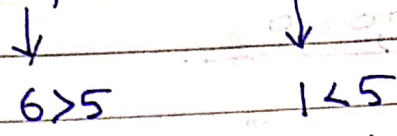

- If the number you are rounding is followed by 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9, round the number up.
For eg:- 38 rounded to the nearest ten is 40
- If the number you are rounding is followed by 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4, round the number down.
For eg:- 33 rounded to the nearest ten is 30
 - * 109 rounded to the nearest hundred is 100
 - * 4521 rounded to the nearest hundred is 4500
 - * 18967 rounded to the nearest ten is 18970
 - * 208599 rounded to the nearest hundred is 208600
