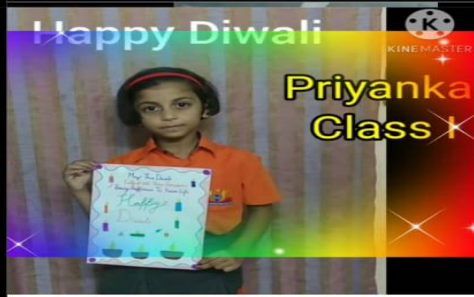
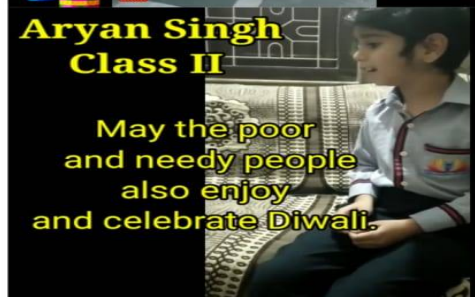
5. Eid-e-Milad-un-Nabi (29.10.2020)
