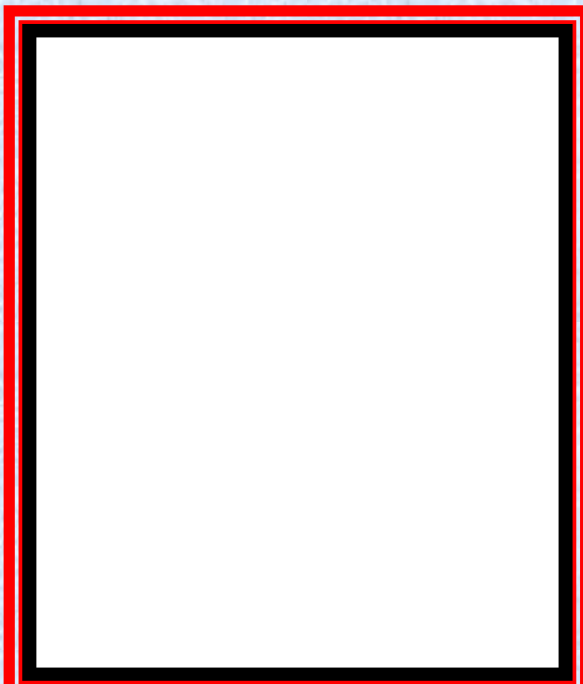

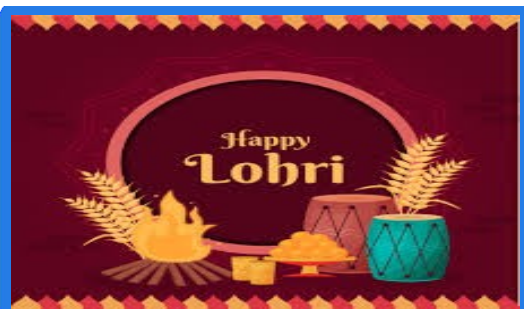


Lohri Celebration

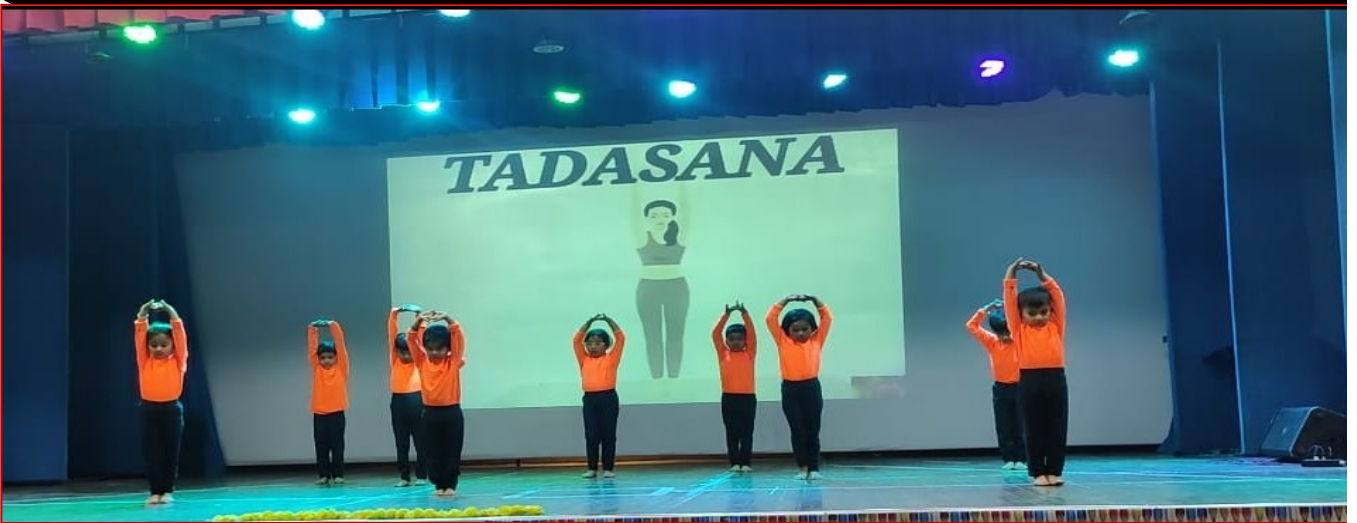

Orientation Session

An orientation session was held for the parents, of students of classes Nursery to VIII, on 1st April, 2023. It commenced with a warm welcome for the parents. It was conducted by the teachers. Mrs. Arpreet Kaur introduced herself and enlightened the parents about the school's mission towards the overall development of students and inculcating values in them. She spoke about the importance of discipline, rules and regulations, punctuality and school activities. She also forwarded a perspective on various aspects of English language education. Slides, Powerpoint presentation and related videos were also shown to the parents which were quite informative and interesting for them.
