
Students of classes I to VIII put up a special assembly to depict the importance of trees and the adverse effects of deforestation.


Through their captivating performances and thought-provoking posters with slogans, the students highlighted the importance of trees and the detrimental effects of deforestation.

SENIOR CITIZEN'S DAY






NATIONAL SPACE DAY

SANSKRIT WEEK 26th August -30th August 2024








HINDI SRIJAN
