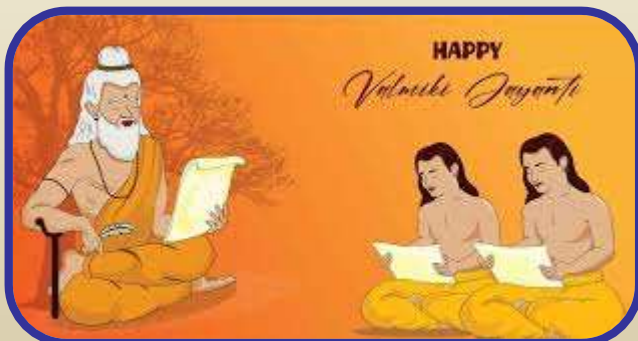




# VALMIKI JAYANTI

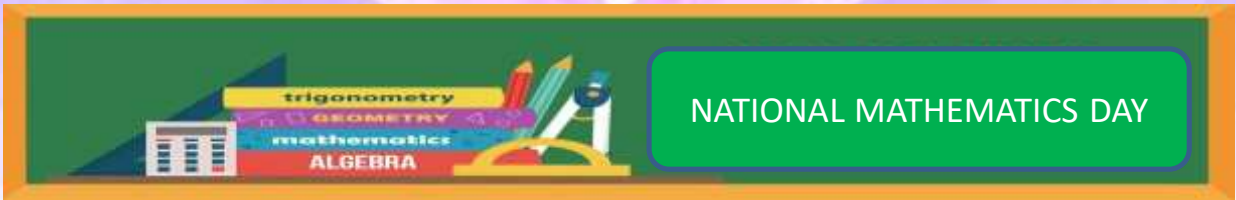

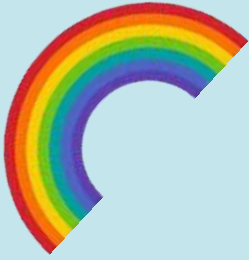
